PIEAS organized a one-week workshop on "Cyber Security Assessment of Instrumentation and Control (I&C) Systems"

The CPS lab, in collaboration with the National Centre for Cyber Security (NCCS), and Directorate of Cyber security, PAEC organized a one-week workshop on "Cyber Security Assessment of Instrumentation and Control (I&C) Systems" from October 3 to 7, 2022. The workshop and CEPS laboratory was inaugurated by DG PINSTECH, Dr. Qamar ul Haq. It gathered 14 industry practitioners from different PAEC organizations.

Director General National Centre for Physics, Prof. Dr. Mansoor Hameed Inayat was the Chief guest of the closing ceremony. Rector, PIEAS Dr. Nasir Majid Mirza, Dean Sciences, Dr. Anila Usman, and Director Cyber Security Directorate Dr. Asmatullah was also present on the occasion.
